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1 Ensure your hands are clean, warm and dry

- Wash hands with soap and water.
- Dry your fingers well

Tip: Ensure your fingers are warm as this will aid with blood collection e.g. after a shower or soaking your hands in warm water.



• Clean the finger with an **Alcohol Wipe.** Tip: Use the little or ring finger of your left hand (if right-handed). Ensure the finger

3 Blood Collection

- Position the Lancet to the side and at the tip of your finger.
- Firmly press the Lancet into the skin to activate and prick your finger in one step.



- Gently milk the full length of the finger, from base to tip, to encourage blood flow.
 - Allow the blood droplets that form to fall into the upright Blood Collection Tube.

Tip: This is best done whilst standing and holding your hand downwards below the level of your waist.



 Continue blood collection in this way until you fill the tube to above the first marked line. Do not overfill!

Tip: Please note that insufficient samples may not be processed. There are 2 spare Lancets provided if you need to repeat the blood collection on another

5 Checklist

- Firmly replace the cap of the Blood Collection tube.
- Gently invert the tube 5 times.
- Wrap the **Patient Label** sticker provided around the tube.

Tip: Ensure you wipe off any excess blood on the outside of the tube.


It is now ready for use.

- Ensure your First Name, Surname and Date of Birth are

- Ensure the Plastic Wallet is sealed with the blood samples and used Lancets inside.
- Put the **Plastic Wallet** with the completed **Return Form** and **Feedback Form** inside the box.
- Close the box and seal it with the Security Seal Sticker.
- Post the box on the same day using the addressed and
- prepaid Postage Label.
